

**NEW YORK COLLEGE LEARNING SKILLS ASSOCIATION (NYCLSA)  
PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR \$500**

**CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS**

**Required:**

1. Applicant has been a member of NYCLSA in good standing for at least two years.
2. Applicant has earned at least a bachelor's degree.
3. Applicant has worked in developmental education or learning assistance for at least two consecutive years.
4. Applicant will describe the anticipated impact of how participation in the institute, workshop or course (*see back*) will contribute to his/her personal and/or professional development, and/or to the program in which s/he works, and how the funds will help achieve these goals.
5. Applicant will submit current resume or curriculum vita.
6. Applicants seeking funding for the Kellogg Institute must submit an application to the Kellogg Institute prior to applying for this scholarship.

**Recommended:**

1. Applicant has demonstrated involvement in NYCLSA, such as attendance at the Annual Symposium, participation in regional conferences, or submission to NYCLSA newsletter or *Research and Teaching in Developmental Education*.
2. Applicant is encouraged to submit a proposal to a future NYCLSA Symposium for a presentation related to theory or program implementation emanating from the activity funded, write a brief article for the NYCLSA newsletter, or write an article for NYCLSA's journal *Research and Teaching in Developmental Education*.
3. Applicant may wish to provide letters of support from his/her supervisor, colleagues and/or students.
