

PROMISING STUDENT AWARD - \$250

The New York College Learning Skills Association (NYCLSA) recognizes the economic struggles that students in our courses and programs may face. We are pleased to offer one \$250 award annually to a student in good standing at an institution of higher education. This award can be used for any expenses related to higher education.

CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in a two- or four-year institution of higher education and must plan to continue at an institution of higher education.
2. Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and passing grades in any developmental courses taken.
3. Applicant must be nominated by a NYCLSA member in good standing (excluding current Board members).
4. Applicants must submit:
 - a) a nomination letter, maximum one page, from a NYCLSA member that speaks to your potential to succeed in college as well as your financial need. This nomination letter must specify your cumulative GPA and your final grade in any developmental courses taken.
 - b) a description of why you feel you should be given the Promising Student Award, specifically how it will help you continue in higher education and support your academic goals, and how your involvement in developmental education has helped you prepare for regular college courses. Your description should be no longer than one page, double-spaced.
